Dear friends,

What a wonderful celebration the wedding of the Duke and Duchess of Sussex was! Even those who are not ardent royalists will have found it difficult not to be moved by it. And right at its heart was the commitment which Harry and Meghan made to one another: "Will you be faithful to one another as long as you both shall live?" "I will."

Faithfulness is at the heart of the ancient institution of marriage. Faithfulness is at the heart of our Christian faith.

Over the last 50 years our attitude to our marriage here in Britain has changed massively. But in spite of declining numbers of weddings, most people have a deep yearning for faithfulness.

Faithfulness means being trustworthy and dependable, serving the other person sacrificially, and consistently proving that over a long period of time.

Where do we get this idea from? That you can consistently prove your love to another person, for the rest of your life? We get it from the God we meet in the pages of the Bible. He is trustworthy and dependable in the long run, even if we are not! In Jesus we see God's faithfulness most clearly: God gives his everything, his own Son, to bring us back to our heavenly Father. Everything that separates us from God, every mistake we've ever made, he nails on the cross on which Jesus dies. His faithfulness even unto death wipes away our unfaithfulness.

"There is power in love." That was the recurring refrain in Bishop Michael Curry's sermon at the royal wedding. The Bible says that the love and complete commitment of a couple in marriage is a reflection of God's even greater faithfulness. I have experienced such encouragement, empowerment and healing in my marriage to a Edda for nearly 24 years now. And it's not just for married couples! In God's economy, all relationships are marked by faithfulness!

Every wedding and marriage, every friendship, every bond of love and commitment can be 'royal', when we know we are royal children of the King of kings, who is utterly dependable, trustworthy, faithful.

May you know a reflection of His faithfulness in the relationships you treasure.
