
Jesus tells his disciples that being a disciple may involve suffering, but no matter how small, they are valued by God.

Do Think about someone you'd like to tell about Jesus. Perhaps you could invite them to come to an event at church. If not, pray for them this week.


Pray As you brush or wash your hair this week, remind yourself that God knows how many hairs are on your head. So, even when things are tough, be thankful that he cares about you and is with you.
