


STARTING SERVICES AT ST MARY'S

A NEW PURPOSE -WHAT AM I HERE FOR? By Nnamdi Maduka

If you are in Christ, you have been given a new identity. God has called you into a new life, rooted in a history that predates you, anchored in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. You discover who you are in Christ, and you are given the DNA to prove it, the Holy Spirit who empowers you to live a holy life.

What am I here for, What are you here for?

The reason we live is to worship God in the beauty of His Holiness! It is only when we discover who we are that we can worship him in the beauty of His holiness.

A thorough and honest assessment of ourselves most time does not showcase us as a holy people. But holiness means being set apart for God's use, to reflect God's character in all of our ways, his goodness and love, his kindness and compassion, his concern for justice and the poor. It's not an optional extra reserved for the few! It is God's expectation for all his people at all times and in all places. God commanded his people, "Be ye holy for I am holy." (Lev 11:44)

UNION with Christ is the anchor of Holiness: We are in Christ and our sanctification (another word for becoming holy) is finished, full and complete. In Christ we were washed, sanctified and justified (1 Cor 6:11). In this sense Holiness is what we receive by faith of what Jesus did on the cross for us all. This is not something we achieve by ourselves. Our union with Christ gives us confidence that our holiness does not fall with our successes or rise with our successes.

Holiness is both what we are and What we called to become; It is the anchor and the engine. "You are in Christ" gives you assurance. "Christ is in you" gives you power. Together they help us move out in confidence. Become what you already are! In calling us to be holy God is not asking us to make up what is lacking in us; we don't obey from a deficit, we obey out of fullness. We see that God is making us beautiful because he is making us like Jesus and he is committed to us over the whole journey.

The Apostles' Creed

kindle in all who minister the gospel
your countless gifts of grace; through
Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
