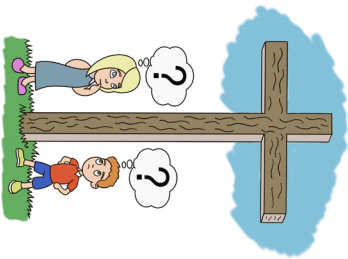

Talk How can we put others first instead of ourselves?

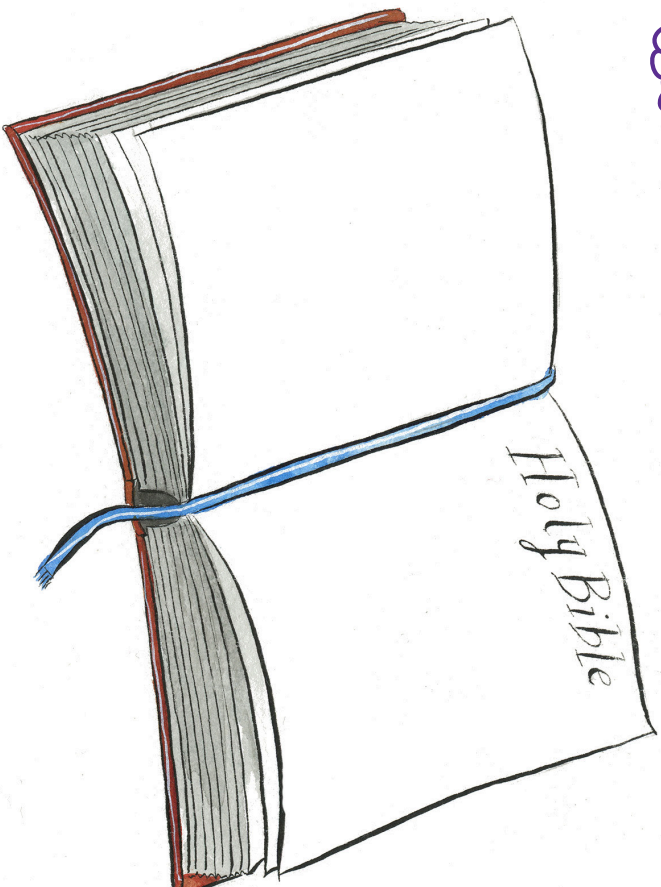
Do Challenge each other to find several things that are 'as hard as they are good' (e.g. sport, faith, hobbies) to try out this week.
