Over the last weeks we have of course all realised that it will be some time until we emerge from the Covid pandemic. Can you and I welcome this difficult season as an opportunity for God to do a deep work in us?

Last year we started to establish healthy habits. So far we have explored prayer, fellowship and generosity. This coming Sunday we will add a fourth one: Learning from the Bible.
