Pentecost is the starting pistol for the story of Jesus' worldwide church — the starting pistol for a marathon that you and I are still part of! Jesus said to his disciples: "Wait for the coming of the Holy Spirit." And when the Spirit came, the disciples threw open the doors and windows, went out into the market place and shared the good news of Jesus. It was the start of Jesus' worldwide church because on that day people of many languages were gathered for a Jewish festival and they all heard the disciples speak the good news in their own languages!

Soon this good news (aka gospel) would spread from Jerusalem to Judea, Samaria and to the ends of the earth – and that includes Denham!

Anyone who has ever run a long distance race knows that you need to top up with water along the way and you need to keep the goal in mind to get to the end. It also helps to be cheered on by those along the route! FIRST READING: ACTS 2. 1-8

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability.

Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. Amazed and astonished, they asked, 'Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language?

SECOND READING: LUKE 4.14-21

Then Jesus, filled with the power of the Spirit, returned to Galilee, and a report about him spread through all the surrounding country. He began to teach in their synagogues and was praised by everyone.

When he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, he went to the synagogue on the sabbath day, as was his custom. He stood up to read, and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written:

'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because

he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour.' And he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant, and sat down. The eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him. Then he began to say to them, 'Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.'

This is the word of the Lord. Thanks be to God.
