The Healthy Habit of Worship

What is Worship? Here are some of the answers you have given:

Finding Gods peace and contentment within our own hearts so we can then reach out to others. | Declaring the greatness of God from every part of our being in every way that we are able. | Worship is like jet-fuel. | Worship is a way of life. | Something we forget to do.

Worship: A Way of Life

It involves all of our life: work, rest, enjoyment of creation, service, eating, giving and, yes, our gatherings with fellow disciples for the focused activity of praise and worship.

Worship: An Expression of Devotion

The most common word for worship in the New Testament means 'come towards and kiss the back of the hand'. It speaks about devotion, humility, intimacy, reverence. Read the account of a woman anointing Jesus in Mathew 26.6-13. As part of a worshipping way of life there need to be poignant, passionate moments.

Worship: a Formative Energy

Together with mission and intentional community, worship is one of the key formative energies of discipleship. "We become like the things we most love and desire." (James Smith)

A Rhythm of Worship

Daily, weekly, at festival times: In any healthy relationship there need to be regular times when we we affirm our love and commitment. Our daily worship may be in special places and times we set aside, or during the commute or while doing the washing up. "The plural of disciple is church." (Alice Morgan). Worship is important whenever we gather as Jesus' disciples.
