# FIRST READING: 1 Samuel 1. 10-17, 24-29

Hannah was deeply distressed and prayed to the Lord, and wept bitterly. She made this vow: 'O Lord of hosts, if only you will look on the misery of your servant, and remember me, and not forget your servant, but will give to your servant a male child, then I will set him before you as a nazirite until the day of his death. He shall drink neither wine nor intoxicants, and no razor shall touch his head.'As she continued praying before the Lord, Eli observed her mouth. Hannah was praying silently; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard: therefore Eli thought she was drunk. So Eli said to her, 'How long will you make a drunken spectacle of yourself? ## **SECOND READING: Luke 2.41-52**
